REHEARSALS & PERFORMANCES:

Please note parents are not permitted backstage during recital. Please provide you child with water and lunch or a snack. Please do not send anything which may soil or stain the costumes. BCDTA does provide a concession stand with drinks and snacks for \$2.00 per item at all stage rehearsals and performances. Students can order lunch with BCDTA to be delivered during the assigned lunch break.

ADMITTANCE TO BACKSTAGE AREAS DURING REHEARSALS/PERFORMANCES:

No parents, grandparents, siblings, or family members are permitted in any backstage areas (hallways, dressing rooms, stage area, etc.) during any rehearsals or performances. This is for the safety of all students and staff, to help minimize confusion and help processes run smoothly, and to ensure that our staff is fully aware of all who are backstage with our students. Please do not ask for exceptions. We have ample staff to safely monitor students and run our processes. If you need a student during a rehearsal or performance time, please see Sue Lynch at the front desk, who will assist you in locating the student. Please also note that parents/family are only permitted to be in the lobby area during rehearsals and are not permitted to be in the auditorium. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

DROP OFF & PICK UP PROCEDURES:

You must sign students in & out on the sign in sheet at cafeteria at Newtown Middle School. 1 parent is welcome to walk your child into the dressing area to get them set up for rehearsals/show. Once we begin, all parents will be asked to leave during the rehearsal/show. After the performance/rehearsal, we ask that 1 parent picks up your child in the dressing area. Parents, please make sure your child is set/cleaned up and exit the dressing area quickly. Families will receive an envelope with a wrist band for Show Day. This wristband MUST be shown to enter the dressing room area. ONLY one per family. If you DO NOT have your wrist band on, you will NOT be able to enter the dressing room. You MUST use the front doors only and NOT the side doors. Please enter and exit the dressing rooms quickly as we have other students and casts coming in. Students ages 12 and older are allowed to exit dressing rooms without their parents (please set up a meeting location)

WHY THESE RULES?

Our main concern is our student's safety and presenting them in the most professional environment possible. Every year, BC Discoveries takes on the monumental task of coordinating hundreds of students, parents and guests. We do not take this responsibility lightly and expect everyone to cooperate with our requests so that your children, our "stars", will have an enjoyable and memorable performance. Thank you, in advance, for your cooperation.

YOU GET TO PICK YOUR SEATS!!!! Just like ticket master, you log in and pick the number of ticket you like and where you would like to sit! Tickets are \$20 for adults, \$10 for children 12 and under, and free admission for lap sitters. Tickets are reserved seating.

Want to send your child something special for after the performance? Aunts, Uncles, Grandparents, and siblings can purchase wishes for their special star too! Does your child have a friend or a teacher that they would like to send a special wish and sweet treat to at the Spring Recital?! Purchase wish & a kisses for \$1 each (or 6 for \$5) at the studio front desk starting on March 1st and receive a card to write a wish on. Return cards to the front desk prior to the show, at the rehearsal, and on the day of the show, and BCDTA staff will pair your special wish with some Hershey Kisses and will distribute wishes to kids after the show! Each student will decorate their own bag during class to hold their special wishes! Please note you must pay for wishes when receiving the cards at the front desk. Make sure to pick up your bag after the show!

"Barbie Hair" FAIRY:

Need help with your Child's Hair for Picture Day or the Recital? Our High School Students would LOVE to do it for you! Cost is \$12/per hairstyle. Price includes comb (new comb for each child) hairspray, hair ties and bobby-pins. You don't need to supply anything. Schedule your hair fairy appointment soon! Space is limited and will sell out! Schedule your time online though studio Director under workshops. (Please come with clean, tangle free hair and bring your own brush)

COSTUMES:

Costumes are yours to keep and do not need to be returned after the show. Costumes will not be handed out to children with a past due balance on their account or unpaid costume fees. Please ensure that your child has all costume pieces, accessories and proper shoes prior to all rehearsals and show day. Please ensure that your child tries on their costume to make sure it fits and inform us immediately of any problems with a costume. ALL costumes, accessories, dance shoes, tights, etc. should be clearly labeled with student's first and last names. Please hang costume on a hanger with hanger labeled as well. Please place a bag over the hanger to hold headpieces, socks, or other accessories.

How Recital is going to work: (Cliff Notes)

- Please arrive on time to Newtown Middle School (Child should be in tights, Nude Leotard, with hair and make up done (Unless you scheduled a hair fairy)
- 1 Parent per child will walk your dancers to the cafeteria (this parent must have the backstage
 wrist band which we will hand out the week before recital) You will sign your child in at the front
 door of the cafeteria.
- Once in the Cafeteria, you will see your Child's class sat together. Please walk them over to their class and set up their belongings. (Daddy/Daughter Costume is first followed by their weekly dance class costume)
- Once your child is dressed, please make your way out of the cafeteria. The sooner the parents
 exit, the better your child will be on stage. It's ok to leave if your child is upset. We know your
 kids and how to clam them down. I promise!
- NO PARENTS WILL BE PERMITTED INTO THE CAFETERIA ONCE THE SHOW BEGINS
- Once Recital is fully finished, we will walk all dancers into the cafeteria. We will not let any parents in until we know every child is off the stage and sitting with their correct group. Once we know the kids are safely back in the cafeteria, we will open the ONE set of doors to allow one parent per child (MUST HAVE WRISTBAND) in to dismiss your child and gather their items. (Students ages 12 and up can leave the cafeteria and meet their families in the lobby) Please set up a meeting location.
- Please sign your child out with the Staff as you exit. You will also be checked as you exit the cafeteria doors.
- Please be patient if you are asked to show your wrist band a few times. We have over 300 kids
 that we need to make sure are safe and going home with the correct families. This is for the
 safety of your children!

What if my child has a costume change?

Our staff and alumni will change them! No need to worry! They NEED A NUDE LEOTARD!

What if my child has a quick or fast costume change?

Please let us know once the list of songs is released. We will assign a changer to your child and they will do their quick change backstage and not in the cafe.

Do I need a nude leotard?

Yes! This is a Council Rock Policy! All students must be fully covered at all times as they are not allowed to turn off security cameras! This also protects the kids on stage incase of any costume mishaps! We don't want any slips getting caught on film! The nude leotard also helps with itchy costumes!

Do Daddy/Daughter Dad's Need a Ticket to the show:

Yes, If they are sitting in the audience they need to reserve a seat!

Are Parents allowed on the stage/backstage?

No! Only Dads performing but they will have special backstage passes which are only valid during the opening number and then dad's must return to their seats in the theater.

Will Dads have enough time to get to their seats after they dance?

Yes! After Daddy/Daughter Dance, Ms Kristina comes out to welcome all the families and introduces our amazing staff! This allows time for Dad's to take their seats and students to change before the recital begins.

How Long does the show run?

We will not have an exact time until it gets closer to the recital, but we are hopeful for a 2.5 hour recital. There is no intermission. Please DO NOT get up for a bathroom break, snacks or to walk around while dances and students are on stage. There are blackouts and scene changes in the script which allow time for this.

Will recital Tickets sell out?

Most likely yes. Do not wait to buy your tickets. Once tickets sell out, there is nothing we can do.

Should we wear your costume to the Recital?

NO! This is like wearing a snowsuit in the car and a safety issue. Please change the kids when you get to the cafeteria.

How does my child get on and off stage?

We have an amazing system! Our Amazing staff and alumni will make sure you child is ready and doesn't miss their dances/scenes or songs. Parents can just sit back and relax in the theater and enjoy the show!
